## **ELIGIBILITY FOR CONTINUED ENROLLMENT**

By the <u>end of the academic year</u> in which the student has attempted 72 hours (including transfer, advanced placement, advanced standing, and credit by examination), "satisfactory progress" toward a B.S. degree in Landscape Contracting will include the following minimum criteria:

Having a quality credit average of at least 2.0, overall and in-major.

Passing at least 24 semester credits that apply to the University Curriculum on Liberal Education.

Passing the following:

Math 1014 and 1025, Chem 1035 and 1036, Hort 2224 or 2234 or 2244

6 credits additional Hort (including those not applied above)

6 credits from CSES 3114 or 3134, ENT 4254, PPWS 4104

**Total credits for graduation** = 120 with a required minimum 2.0 GPA overall and in-major (includes all classes in BIOL, HORT, AAEC, CSES, ENT, PPWS, CHEM) Note: A sequence of two foreign language courses is required unless two years of the same high school foreign language or 6 transfer credits of the same foreign language are completed. These credits **do not** count toward graduation requirements.
