Students are responsible for completing the Curriculum for Liberal Education requirements that are in effect when they enter the university.

GPA Requirements and Progress towards Degree

Students must maintain an overall GPA of 2.0 and an in-major GPA of 2.0. Upon having attempted 72 semester hours (including transfer, AP, advanced standing and credit by exam) an Art History student must have completed at least 6 credits towards this major with a 2.0 overall GPA and have a minimum of a 2.0 in-major GPA. All major requirements and electives count towards the in-major GPA.

Foreign Language Requirement

Students who do not successfully complete at least two units of a single foreign language, classical language or American Sign Language during high school must successfully complete six semester hours of a single college level foreign language or classical language at the college level. Such semester hours are in addition to those normally required for graduation. Please see the undegraduate catalogue for details.
