Curriculum for Liberal Education Requirements

Students are responsible for completing the Curriculum for Liberal Education requirements that are in effect when they enter the university. The university requires students to complete course work from all seven areas of the Curriculum for Liberal Education.

GPA Requirements



Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA. In-major GPA requires a grade of C- or better to successfully complete a Studio Art course. In-major GPA is calculated on all ART courses.

Satisfactory Progress Toward Degree

The University requires every department to establish benchmarks by which their majors can demonstrate that they are making satisfactory progress toward a degree. In addition to the University requirement for satisfactory progress (See Satisfactory Progress in Academics chapter of Undergraduate Catalogue), in the case of the Studio Art major, these benchmarks are:

- 1. Students must maintain a C- or better in required Foundations courses (1204, 1404, 1604, 1214, 1414).
- 2. Upon having attempted 72 semester hours (including transfer, AP, advanced standing and credit by exam) a Studio Art student must have completed at least 6 credits towards this major with a 2.0 overall GPA and have a minimum 2.0 in-major GPA.
- 3. Students must successfully complete their BFA exhibition (ART 4894).

Prerequisites

Foreign Language Requirement

Students who do not successfully complete at least two units of a single foreign language, classical language or American Sign Language during high school must successfully complete six semester hours of a single college level foreign language or classical language at the college level. Suche semester hours are in addition to those normally required for graduation. Please see the undegraduate catalogue for details.

Double-Counting

No more that 50% of the graded course credits required for Minor: Art History may be double-counted by a student also enrolled in Major: Studio Art.
