A grade of C- or better is required in the following ITDS studio courses: ITDS 2044, ITDS 2054, ITDS 3044, ITDS 3054, ITDS 4044, ITDS 4054.
- 3. Foreign Language requirement: students who did not complete two units of foreign language in high school must earn six credits of foreign language to satisfy the foreign language requirement. These six credits will not count toward the overall 120 required for graduation.
