## Satisfactory Progress Towards Degree

Upon having completed 72 credit hours (including transfer, AP, advanced standing, credit by examination, course withdrawal) students must have completed the following courses with a grade of C- or better in two or fewer attempts (including attempts that were withdrawn): BIOL 1105, BIOL 1106, BIOL 1115, BIOL 1116, BIOL 2004, CHEM 1035-1036, CHEM 1045-1046, CHEM 2535, MATH 1225-1226, PHYS 2205-2206, and PHYS 2215-2216. This also applies to acceptable substitutions

## **Graduation Requirements**

120 credit hours are required for graduation. These credits must include the courses required for the major (see above section). To graduate, a student must have at least a 2.0 in-major GPA and 2.0 overall GPA. If 120 credit hours are reached and a student does not meet the GPA requirement, the student must take additional in-major courses to raise the in-major GPA to a 2.0. **\*In Major GPA:** Courses used to calculate in-major GPA
