

Annual Report to CUSP on the Academic Appeals Committee  
November 10, 2014

The Academic Appeals Committee consists of the university academic deans, and a representative from the faculty, the Dean of Students Office and the Office of Undergraduate Academic Affairs.

For academic probation/suspension appeals during the academic years of 2012-13 and 2013-14, 107 and 120 total cases, respectively, were reviewed.

Total of 107 appeals processed in 2012-13, 43 approved, 64 denied.

Total of 120 appeals processed in 2013-14, 44 approved, 76 denied.
