Introduction of particpants.

Action items from last meeting:

- a. space in the library
- b. how faculty can work with the library in support of Pathways.

Martina: Graduate students lounge is always full and graduate students would like more space. They would like their own space.

Tyler: We're open to input. Our largest problem is lack of square footage.

Idea: dedicated carrels for graduate students.

Graduate student lounge has 40 seats

There are 1200 student seats in library

Graduate students have a lounge in the GLC, as well as the GLC building to study in.

Martina suggests a carrel with a white board. Locked small space would be ideal, but a dedicated space would be ideal whether it's locked or not. The students need something more private. We need a bigger facility. That may come eventually in partial new building spaces.

We have funded spaces in the library (MPR, etc.)

Impact of letter of University Library Committee to University Commons. Last time there was no impact.

Collect more data by organizing focus groups and collecting data on current graduate student lounge use.

What can we do with current graduate student lounge to make it more effective?
