## Resolution to Approve New Major, Management Consulting & Analytics, in Bachelor of Science in Business in Management

WHEREAS, Management Consulting & Analytics (MCA) has been an option within the Management major under the BS in Business degree (approved 2006, effective for the graduating class of 2010); and

**WHEREAS,** in 2021, the consulting industry is expected to grow by 8.6% (Source: IBIS World) leading to high demand for new consultants; and

**WHEREAS**, the Management department prepares students with a clear focus on the consulting industry and provides success-critical skills and competencies to students that are specific to the role of a management consultant; and

**WHEREAS**, making MCA a major rather than an option will increase the visibility and appeal of the degree to both prospective students as well as employers who seek students with specific interests and training; and

**WHEREAS**, making MCA a major rather than an option will allow students to certify to prospective employers their education in MCA as the name of major is represented on both the academic transcript and the diploma; and

**WHEREAS**, making MCA a major rather than an option will allow the department to gain additional recognition from external sources for our expertise and strengths in MCA; and

WHEREAS, making MCA a major rather than an option will help the department facilitate affinity from alumni of the major; and

**WHEREAS,** currently, the MCA option has approximately 210 students. Elevating this option to a major will allow the department to increase enrollment over time as a result of increased visibility of the major to prospective students and employers.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Major in Management Consulting & Analytics under the Bachelor of Science in Business in Management within the Pamplin College of Business be approved effective Summer 2022 and the proposal forwarded through University governance to the President for approval.
