A minimum of 57 credit hours in Theatre and Cinema is required to complete the B.A. degree in Theatre Arts under the Performance Option; 27 common degree core credits as listed, plus 12 credits of required courses, a minimum of 9 credits of specified Performance courses, and 9 credit hours of Department of Theatre and Cinema electives. A total of 120 hours is required for the degree, including Pathways credits and free electives.
