## **Cinema Major Requirements**

A minimum of 57 credit hours in Theatre and Cinema is required to complete the B.A. degree in Theatre Arts with a Cinema Major; 27 common degree core credits as listed, plus 15 credits of defined cinema courses, 6 credits of additional required courses, and 9 credit hours of Department of Theatre and Cinema electives. A total of 120 hours is required for the degree, including Pathways credits and free electives.
