### **Department Policies**

### **GPA / Grade Requirements**

To fulfill graduation requirements in the major, all courses used to fulfill requirements in the Music major must be completed with a grade of C or better. None of these courses may be repeated more than once for the purposes of raising the grade to C or better. An overall and in-major GPA of 2.0 or higher is required. All Music courses are used in calculating the major GPA except MUS 1005, 1006, 1104, 2115, and 2116.

#### Satisfactory Progress Toward Degree

In addition to University requirements, students must complete the following by the end of the semester in which they attempt 54 credit hours:

A) Continuation Exam Requirement, Keyboard Proficiency Requirement, Convocation and Concert Attendance Requirement

B) MUS 2025, 2026, 2045, 2046, 3025, 3026, 3174 plus 2 hours of either MUS 3314 or 3414

Students in the Creative Technologies in Music Option must complete either a Senior Project or Junior Recital prior to graduation. Program will process transaction when requirement has been met.
