ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND ADMISSION PROCEDURES

Any student (including first semester first-year and transfer students) is eligible to apply for the Real Estate minor. Students pursuing the Real Estate major or the Finance major with the—Real Estate Option are not eligible to pursue the Real Estate minor.

In addition to fulfilling the requirements of their individual majors, students must complete the 25 credit hours listed on the attached sheet with at least a 2.5 average in these 25 credit hours. The minor will be noted on the student's transcript. Including prerequisites students need a minimum of 2 academic years or 4 semesters to complete the minor.
