In addition to fulfilling the requirements of their individual majors, students must complete the minor with at least a 2.0 in the 18 semester hours required by the minor. The minor will be noted on the student's transcript. Students may apply major courses to the minor, not to exceed 50% overlap (except COMM/PR/MJ majors).
