REQUIREMENTS: 18 semester hours of coursework in Latin and/or Classical and New Testament Greek from the following list, including at least 6 credit hours at the 3000 or 4000 level. With the exception of Latin 1105, Latin 1106, Greek 1105, Greek 1106, and Latin 4004 all courses are variable-content courses and may be repeated for credit up to three times with different content. For substitutions, see your advisor for Classical Languages.

- A student must complete all courses with a minimum 2.0 GPA for all hours attempted. In addition a minimum grade of C is required of all Foreign Language Minors in <u>each</u> of the required courses for the minor.
- Required courses may be transferred only with the approval of your advisor for the Latin Minor.
- Authorization to take coursework elsewhere should be obtained <u>beforehand</u> from the Dean's Office and the Chair of the Department of Modern and Classical Languages and Literatures.

N.B.

- (1) Classics 2444 (= Eng 2444 and RLCL 2444) and Classics 2454 do not count toward a Latin Minor.
- (2) No course required for the Classical Language Minor may be taken Pass/Fail.
