ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

In order to apply for a Minor in ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) Analytics, students must have a GPA of 2.50 or above.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

The Minor in Environmental, Social and Governance Analytics requires 24 credit hours of course work as described above. In order to graduate, students must have a 2.00 GPA in all courses used to fulfill the minor.

To remain in the Minor in Environmental, Social and Governance Analytics program, students must maintain a GPA of at least 2.00 in the courses listed above. A grade of C or better in FIN 3134, 3144, and 3154 is required to receive a Minor in Environmental, Social and Governance Analytics. Students who receive a grade of C- in FIN 3134 may enroll concurrently in FIN 3144 and FIN 3154 while re-taking FIN 3134. Students who receive a grade of C- in FIN 3144 and FIN 3154 may enroll concurrently in FIN 3154 while re-taking FIN 3134. Students who receive a grade of C or better in FIN 3144 and FIN 3154 may enroll concurrently in FIN 4204 while re-taking FIN 3144 and FIN 3154. A grade of C or better in FIN 3134 is required before enrolling in FIN 4204.
